The Gospel of Luke

Blessed

2 words in Hebrew that carry a similar idea, same in Greek

1. praying for something you don't have, Lord BLESS so and SO

2. Affirmation/Announcement of a state that you recognize already to be present

This second one is the one in the beatitudes = MAKARIOS

BLESSED ARE THE Poor or Poor in Spirit

- Luke 6:24

Old Siriac Translation:

“How joyous it is for the poor in spirit in that THEIRS IS the Kingdom of Heaven”

The Gospel of Luke

- Luke 6:21a

BLESSED ARE those that HUNGER NOW

Hab. 1:2-4 How long, O LORD, will I call for help, And You will not hear? I cry out to You, "Violence!" Yet You do not save.

Why do You make me see iniquity, And cause me to look on wickedness? Yes, destruction and violence are before me; Strife exists and contention arises.

Therefore the law is ignored And justice is never upheld. For the wicked surround the righteous; Therefore justice comes out perverted.
