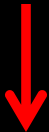
The Gospel of Luke

2. *False sense of self = "I'm fine"*



3. *Outward focus = become moralistic = Judgmental*

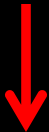

The Gospel of Luke

Some thoughts to chew on:

1. *Money is not really so much a POSSESSION as it is a TRUST*

“If you haven’t been faithful with unrighteous things like material possessions, who on earth would entrust the mysteries of life to you?”
