They already have the blessing of the Master And yet HE SERVES THEM!

2. Luke 22 – Jesus serving His Disples

#### **General Observations**

- 1. "But which of you..."
- 2. "having A slave..."
  - Assumes authority and complete adherence
  - Deep sense of security this relationship affords

#### Master/"Slave" relationship

- Noble Master offers loyalty, blessing, security, dignity & worth
- Servant in return offers loyalty, obedience, & a dedication to working hard

Luke 17:8-10

Literal translation = "Does he have any favor/grace for the servant?"

"thank= to hold benefit/favor = IN DEBT

#### **POINT:**

Does the Master OWE the Servant anything because he simply carried out what he was asked to do?

Achreios

More literally = We are servants whom <u>nothing is</u> <u>owed</u>...we have simply done our duty!

#### What response is Jesus looking for?

- 1. We have no claims on God
- 2. We are not equal (in both who we are and what we deliver) HE IS THE MASTER
