#### 3 Great Pilgrim Feasts: Outlined in Leviticus & Exodus

- 1) <u>Feast of Weeks or 1<sup>st</sup> Fruits</u> Shavuot (50 days after Passover)
- 2) Feast of Booths or Tabernacles Sukkot
- 3) Passover & Feast of Unleavened Bread

Passover = Celebration of the Divine Liberation of Israel from Egypt

2) <u>Feast of Unleavened Bread</u> – Commemorates how Israel ate only unleavened bread on the eve of the Exodus

#### 3 Great Pilgrim Feasts: Earthly & Spiritual Fulfillment

- 1) Passover = Jesus the Lamb of God slain for us
- 2) Shavuot or Feast of 1st Fruits giving of the Holy Spirit
- 3) <u>Sukkot</u> "In Gathering" awaiting fulfillment
