# The Gospel of Luke

## 3 Great Pilgrim Feasts: Outlined in Leviticus & Exodus

- 1) Feast of Weeks or 1<sup>st</sup> Fruits – Shavuot (50 days after Passover)
  - 2) Feast of Booths or Tabernacles - Sukkot
  - 3) Passover & Feast of Unleavened Bread
-

# The Gospel of Luke

- 1) Passover = Celebration of the Divine Liberation of Israel from Egypt
  - 2) Feast of Unleavened Bread – Commemorates how Israel ate only unleavened bread on the eve of the Exodus

# The Gospel of Luke

## 3 Great Pilgrim Feasts: Earthly & Spiritual Fulfillment

- 1) Passover = Jesus the Lamb of God slain for us
  - 2) Shavuot or Feast of 1<sup>st</sup> Fruits – giving of the Holy Spirit
  - 3) Sukkot – “In Gathering” awaiting fulfillment
