The Acts of the Apostles <u>Review:</u>


- 1. Jesus has reinterpreted God's "restoration of Israel"

- 4. Added the 12th Apostle back representing the renewed Israel
- 5. Spirit of the Father is now coming
- 6. Wider audience represents all lands of the diaspora
