
Suffering Servant Song: Is. 52:13-53-12

- 1. Submissive & silent
- 2. Humiliated & deprived of justice
- 3. No Descendants
- 4. Punished for the sins of others
- 5. And yet He brings healing & peace
- 6. Lifted up & exalted

- Acts 8:34-35
- 1. Begins w/ claim He will benefit ALL Nations
- 2. Continues w/ His story of rejection & suffering on behalf of others
- 3. His willingness to suffer despite the incredible injustice
- 4. Concludes w/ how the Father will take His poured out life and accept it as an offering for sin

- Acts 8:36-38
- 1. Philip was there
- 2. Philip was available
- 3. Philip was prepared with an understanding of God's Story
- 4. Philip loved, listened, explained when God prompted, & respected his process/timing
