It was a time of prosperity and relative relief from the attacks of neighboring empires


Encountering Amos today

- Jump into the story and the context
- Wrestle with the implications and let the Spirit speak to you and shake you up
- Remember, we can learn what God cares about, what makes God angry

Implications for today

- God has Amos speak out about "nations" so there are implications for how a "nation" functions
- Each country is addressed as one country or people, not as individuals
- There are systems set up in every civilization that affect people differently: political systems, economic systems, judicial systems

Amos 1:3-5 Damascus (Syria)



Damascus Amos 1:3-5

³Thus says the LORD:

For three transgressions of Damascus,


and for four, I will not revoke the punishment;

because they have threshed Gilead

with threshing sledges of iron.

⁴ So I will send a fire on the house of Hazael, and it shall devour the strongholds of Ben-hadad.

Amos 1:6-8 Gaza (Philistines)



Gaza Amos 1:6-8

⁶Thus says the LORD: For three transgressions of Gaza, and for four, I will not revoke the punishment; because they carried into exile entire communities, to hand them over to Edom.


⁷So I will send a fire on the wall of Gaza, fire that shall devour its strongholds.

⁸ I will cut off the inhabitants from Ashdod, and the one who holds the scepter from Ashkelon;

I will turn my hand against Ekron,

and the remnant of the Philistines shall perish, says the Lord GOD.

Amos 1:9-10 Tyre (Phoenicia)



Tyre Amos 1:9-10

⁹Thus says the LORD:

For three transgressions of Tyre,


and for four, I will not revoke the punishment;

because they delivered entire communities over to Edom,

and did not remember the covenant of kinship.

¹⁰ So I will send a fire on the wall of Tyre, fire that shall devour its strongholds.

Amos 1:11-12 Edom



Edom Amos 1:11-12

¹¹Thus says the LORD:

For three transgressions of Edom,

and for four, I will not revoke the punishment;


because he pursued his brother with the sword

and cast off all pity;

he maintained his anger perpetually, and kept his wrath forever.

¹² So I will send a fire on Teman, and it shall devour the strongholds of Bozrah.

Amos 1:13-15 Ammonites



Ammonites Amos 1:13-15

¹³ Thus says the LORD:

For three transgressions of the Ammonites,

and for four, I will not revoke the punishment;


because they have ripped open pregnant women in Gilead in order to enlarge their territory.

¹⁴ So I will kindle a fire against the wall of Rabbah, fire that shall devour its strongholds,

with shouting on the day of battle, with a storm on the day of the whirlwind;

¹⁵ then their king shall go into exile, he and his officials together, says the LORD.

Amos 2:1-3 Moab



Moab Amos 2:1-3

¹Thus says the LORD:

For three transgressions of Moab, and for four, I will not revoke the punishment;

because he burned to lime the bones of the king of Edom.


² So I will send a fire on Moab, and it shall devour the strongholds of Kerioth,

and Moab shall die amid uproar, amid shouting and the sound of the trumpet;

³ I will cut off the ruler from its midst, and will kill all its officials with him,

says the LORD.

Amos 2:1-3 Judah



Summary of Oracles Against the Nations

Violence, war and more violence

Lack of compassion or empathy for other people

Judah Amos 2:4-5

⁴Thus says the LORD:


For three transgressions of Judah, and for four, I will not revoke the punishment;

because they have rejected the law of the LORD, and have not kept his statutes,

but they have been led astray by the same lies after which their ancestors walked.

⁵ So I will send a fire on Judah, and it shall devour the strongholds of Jerusalem.

Amos 2:6-16 Israel!?



Israel Amos 2:6-9

⁶ Thus says the LORD: For three transgressions of Israel, and for four, I will not revoke the punishment;

because they sell the righteous for silver, and the needy for a pair of sandals

⁷ they who trample the head of the poor into the dust of the earth, and push the afflicted out of the way; father and son go in to the same girl, so that my holy name is profaned;

⁸ they lay themselves down beside every altar on garments taken in pledge;

and in the house of their God they drink wine bought with fines they imposed.

Israel Amos 2:6-9

- "sell the righteous for silver, and the needy for a pair of sandals."
- "they who trample the head of the poor into the dust of the earth and push the afflicted away"
- "garments taken in pledge"
- "in the house of God they drink wine bought with fines they imposed."

Israel Amos 2:9-16
