The Righteousness of God proven through Messiah, King Jesus

During 2nd Temple period world view that history divided into 2 stages:

> The "Present Age"

➤ The "Age to Come"

The church should live in the reality of the "age to come":

A worship that is worthy of thinking reasonable beings

Paul appeals for us to worship God

> By offering our whole being as a LIVE ONGOING sacrifice

➢ BASED upon/because of all of the riches we have from Him (chapters 3-11)

> And it gives Him GREAT pleasure

And it is a worthy thing for reasonable & rational beings in His Kingdom

Any other response is actually irrational

Section IB – Romans 12:3-13: Church Unity

...in the Messiah Christians should now strive for unity

Romans 12:3

Given what Paul said for 11 chapters in how far off we were:
1)Dead in slavery to the <u>force</u> of sin
2)Now made alive by the life & death & resurrection of Jesus
3)Acquitting us of all our guilt, declaring us righteous before Him now

Section IB – Romans 12:3-13: Church Unity

Romans 12:3

Think now in terms of 12:1-2: Proper MIND-SET

a)Offer God true worship – i.e. yourself as one made free & alive

b)Be transformed by having your minds renewed (buy into the reality of who He is and what He has done for you)

c)Thinking of yourselves as one people in Messiah

Literally "Do not over-think above what you ought to think, but think in wide-thinking ways."

Section IB – Romans 12:3-13: Church Unity

Romans 12:4-8

<u>Point</u> = Just as Paul was graced with a gift for his task of establishing & maturing churches, so they EACH have been graced with gifts to bless each other

Section IB – Romans 12:3-13: Church Unity

Romans 12:9-13

This is how we know we are genuine: i.e. being rational:

1)Loathe (hate isn't strong enough) what is evil

2)Cling tightly to what is good

3) Have mutual affection – only comes thru a deep sense of empathy

4)Go first and lead the way in showing honor – Asks yourself, is this helpful to them?

5)Don't be lazy when it comes to diligence – If you are gonna do it anyway, then just do it!

Section IB – Romans 12:3-13: Church Unity

Romans 12:9-13

This is how we know we are genuine: i.e. being rational:

6)Be hopeful – Speak reality but have the perspective of God's faithfulness

7)Be patient – Don't lose sight of what God has brought you up from when thinking of others but especially be patient in your suffering...He will come thru!

8)Be prayerful – Come alongside them with the Trinity.

9) Give – Why? Because none of it is yours anyway. Keep holes in your pockets.

10)Be hospitable – Remember Acts? One of the 4 great pillars of a healthy church. Who has eaten in your house lately?

The "gift" is primarily for SOMEONE ELSE!
