Genesis 30:43-31:2

- There's only one answer from a Faithful Father... I am and will continue to be with you and will do and be all that I have said to you.
- Vs. 3 Jacob and Laban's relationship changes
- God makes clear his relationship with Jacob has neither changed nor degenerated.

Jacob's Flight from Laban

Genesis 31:4-7; 12b-13

- Vs. 7 But God did not permit him to harm me.
- God will judge and protect perfectly in our lives.

Jacob's Flight from Laban

Genesis 31:14-18

- Jacob gives God credit for his success
- Jacob refers to "your father" and "your father's land" vs. "my father's God"
 - 1. One has driven them away.
 - 2. The other is drawing them near.

Jacob's Flight from Laban

Genesis 31:29-30

- •Laban: "It's in my power to do you harm"
- Distorted view of reality

Jacob's Flight from Laban

Genesis 31:42

- •Real Talk
- •Puffed up egos
- •Role of importance
- Forcing our knowledge or wisdom
- "How dare they..." or "Don't you know who I am?"
- "Im in control!"
 - A lie believed as truth, will affect you like truth. But, will destroy you like a lie.

Genesis 31:44-50

- "Let's make a covenant"
 - ➤ Mizpah = Watchpost

Jacob's Flight from Laban

Genesis 31:51-54

• If anyone had a reason to take what they deserve, it would be Jacob.

Jacob swears by the Fear of Isaac:

- · Continuing to walk in faithfulness
- Doesn't argue... Rather, moves into action. (Tucking himself close to the Faithful Father)
- •We see The Faithful Father continuing to be present!
