**b**)After working his way up the wife wants him – frames him…ends up in an Egyptian prison


c)God blesses him again – finds favor with the Chief jailer


- d)After a lengthy time baker & cup bearer and yet again forgotten

- > The country was run by foreign Semitic people called the Hyksos







### Genesis 46:8-27
