## Joshua 4:10-11

- 1) They go in ankle deep with the ark
  - 2) The water dams up from Adam all the way to the Dead Sea visible to Jericho
  - 3) The priests holding the ark stand in the middle on dry ground
  - 4) The people pass thru also on dry ground
  - 5) Meanwhile 12 men 1 from each tribe grab these boulders and pull them out and place them on the other side
  - 6) Then they take 12 more boulders and make a memorial in the middle of the river essentially at the feet of the Presence of God

- 7) With everyone safely across and the river memorial built and the 2<sup>nd</sup> set of stones set aside, the Priests finish by taking the ark across and the waters start flowing again

## Joshua 4:19-24 – Tribal Memorial

### *Joshua 4:19-20*

- “10<sup>th</sup> day of the 1<sup>st</sup> month” = the day for selecting the Passover lamb (Ex. 12:3)
- “Gilgal” – Adjacent to Jericho West of the Jordan
