
Several items to note in chapters 13-21:

1) The sections of land are allotted by lot thru Joshua by way of Moses -Joshua 14:1-3
2) As a reminder the 2 1/2 tribes of Gad, Reuben, and Manasseh already had their land east of the Jordan
3) Caleb – God honors his family with a special portion not forgetting how he exhibited faith alongside Joshua when they spied out the land
4) Levites – Not given land – God was their inheritance – instead 48 cities

5) The Tabernacle was moved to a semi-permanent place in Shiloh before it finally rests permanently in the Temple in Jerusalem under David and eventually Solomon 6)7 of the tribes are quite sluggish -Joshua 18:1-3 7)God's merciful care of the downcast




Joshua 21:43-45


