- ➤ Who brings hostility
- > Who has so much authority Joseph was unable to even name Him
- ➤ And yet steps into our place substitutes His life for ours

- > Teaching & healing and great crowds start gathering

Remember He stepped OUT OF the OT (recapitulate) & INTO our pain (substitute)

For us to STEP OUT in His call, we must first STEP INTO His Kingdom

- g)Become peacemakers = fighting for the rights of others

Matthew 5:1-9: It is only thru HIS empowerment we can do this

- a)We <u>break</u> = and He brings us into His Kingdom
- b)We mourn over what we are like = He comforts us
- c)We are <u>meek</u> & submit to His will = And His Kingdom come to earth is poured out to us
- d)We then <u>long</u> for Him to make things right = and HE feeds us
- e)We feel/give mercy = and He gives it right back to us
- f)We live <u>purely</u> not before men but before God = and as a result we experience the Presence of God
- g)We <u>fight for other's rights</u> = And He calls us HIS And this is ALL because Jesus did for US FIRST

- > Why can we be rich? Because He became poor
- > Why can we be comforted? Because He mourned
- ➤ Why are you and I inheriting the earth? Because He was stripped of everything
- > Why can you and I be filled? Because on the cross He said I am thirsty
- > Why will you and I see God? Because He was pure (single minded)
- > Why do we have peace? Because everyone turned against Him
