<u>Matt. 20:15</u> Is it not lawful for me to do what I wish with what is my own? Or is your eye (singular) envious because I am generous?' (Parable of Laborers in vineyard)

<u>Prov. 22:9</u> Whoever has a generous eye will be blessed, for he shares his bread with the poor.

Col. 3:1-4 If then you have been raised with Messiah, seek (continually inquiring, demanding, searching, giving energy towards, passionate with) the things that are above, where Messiah is, seated at the right hand of God. [2] Set your minds on (concern yourself with) things that are above, not on things that are on earth. [3] For you have died, and your life is hidden with Messiah in God. [4] When Messiah who is your life appears, then you also will appear with him in glory.

<u>I Peter 2:9</u> But you are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people for his own **possession**, that you may proclaim the excellencies of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light. [10] Once you were not a people, but now you are God's people; once you had not received mercy, but now you have received mercy.

<u>Proverbs 10:3</u> The LORD does not let the righteous go hungry, but He thwarts the craving of the wicked.

I Tim. 6:17 As for the rich in this present age, charge them not to be haughty, nor to set their hopes on the uncertainty of riches, but on God, who <u>richly provides us with everything to enjoy</u>. [18] They are to do good, to be rich in good works, to be generous and ready to share, [19] thus storing up treasure for themselves as a good foundation for the future, <u>so that they may take hold of that which is truly life</u>.
