<u>Daniel 7:9</u> "As I looked, thrones were placed, & the Ancient of Days took His seat; His clothing was white as snow, & the hair of His head like pure wool; His throne was fiery flames; its wheels were burning fire. [10] A stream of fire issued & came out from before Him; a thousand thousands served Him, & ten thousand times ten thousand stood before Him; the court sat in judgment, & the books were opened.

"You sound eager to follow Me but you have not considered how different following Me might be to what you expect"

Matthew 8:21-22 – Would-be follower # 2 = The "Disciple"

<u>Ibn al-Salibi</u> – Middle Eastern Syriac Theological scholar "Let me go and bury" = Let me go and serve my father while he is alive and after he dies I will bury him and come"

<u>Ibrahim Sa'id - an Arabic Theological Scholar agrees</u> "The 2nd would-be disciple is looking far into the future for he postpones following Jesus to a time AFTER the death of his father"

Reviewing the first two would-be followers:

1)To the 1st guy who is eager to follow Jesus says you don't know what that means...My road is a road of suffering & losing on behalf of others

2)To the 2nd guy - If you want to follow Me, then you cannot put Me off, & you may be required to cut against the norm of expectations






Matthew 8:23-27 – Would-be follower # 3 = THE Disciples

<u>Hab. 3:15</u> You trampled on the sea with Your horses, On the surge of many waters <u>Job 9:8</u> Who alone stretches out the heavens And tramples down the waves of the sea; <u>Psalm 65:7</u> Who stills the roaring of the seas, The roaring of their waves, And the tumult of the peoples.

Psalm 89:9 You rule the swelling of the sea; When its waves rise, You still them.

<u>Psalm 107:23-30</u> Those who go down to the sea in ships, Who do business on great waters; ²⁴ They have seen the works of the LORD, And His wonders in the deep. ²⁵ For He spoke and raised up a stormy wind, Which lifted up the waves of the sea. ²⁶ They rose up to the heavens, they went down to the depths; Their soul melted away in their misery. ²⁷ They reeled and staggered like a drunken man, And [£]were at their wits' end. ²⁸ Then they cried to the LORD in their trouble, And He brought them out of their distresses. ²⁹ He caused the storm to be still, So that the waves of the sea were hushed. ³⁰ Then they were glad because they were quiet, So He guided them to their desired haven.

Matthew – "Why Jesus?"

The 5th response!

<u>Luke 8:38</u> The man from whom the demons had gone begged that he might be with Him, but Jesus sent him away, saying, [39] "Return to your home, and declare how much God has done for you." <u>And he went</u> away, proclaiming throughout the whole city how much Jesus had done for him.

The 5th response!

Jesus restores this man's LIFE:

> A man had Demons – "the demons had gone from the man"

He had worn no clothes – "he was clothed"

> He did not live in a house but in the tombs – "return to your home"

> He fell down before Him and shouted – "he was sitting at the feet of Jesus"

> The demon seized him & he was out of control – "he was in his right mind"

> He was kept under guard with shackles and chains – "he was restored to his community"

Matthew – "Why Jesus?"

The 5th response!

Here is a man that:

➤ Was full of demons

➢ Receives Salvation

> Shows how bonded & full of gratitude with Jesus he is by wanting to go anywhere Jesus goes

> Who then responds like a Disciple and becomes the first person to be commissioned by Jesus for missional work to another place

Conclusion:

Following Jesus means:

1)Pouring yourself out...losing possibly so that they might gain
2)NOW in trust & abandonment...not when it makes sense to you
3)Dropping YOUR expectations & in trust letting Him have His way
4)Setting God in the proper context of Scripture not what YOU THINK
