- b) “Orderly” = one after the other

The Gospel of Luke

Luke and Acts Similarities:

- Begin in Jerusalem
 - Luke ends/Acts begins w commissioning
 - Each covers roughly 30 years
 - Jesus last days in Jerusalem & Paul's arrest, trial, & arrival in Rome each takes up roughly 25% of each book
 - Parallels between Jesus in Luke and Apostles in Acts

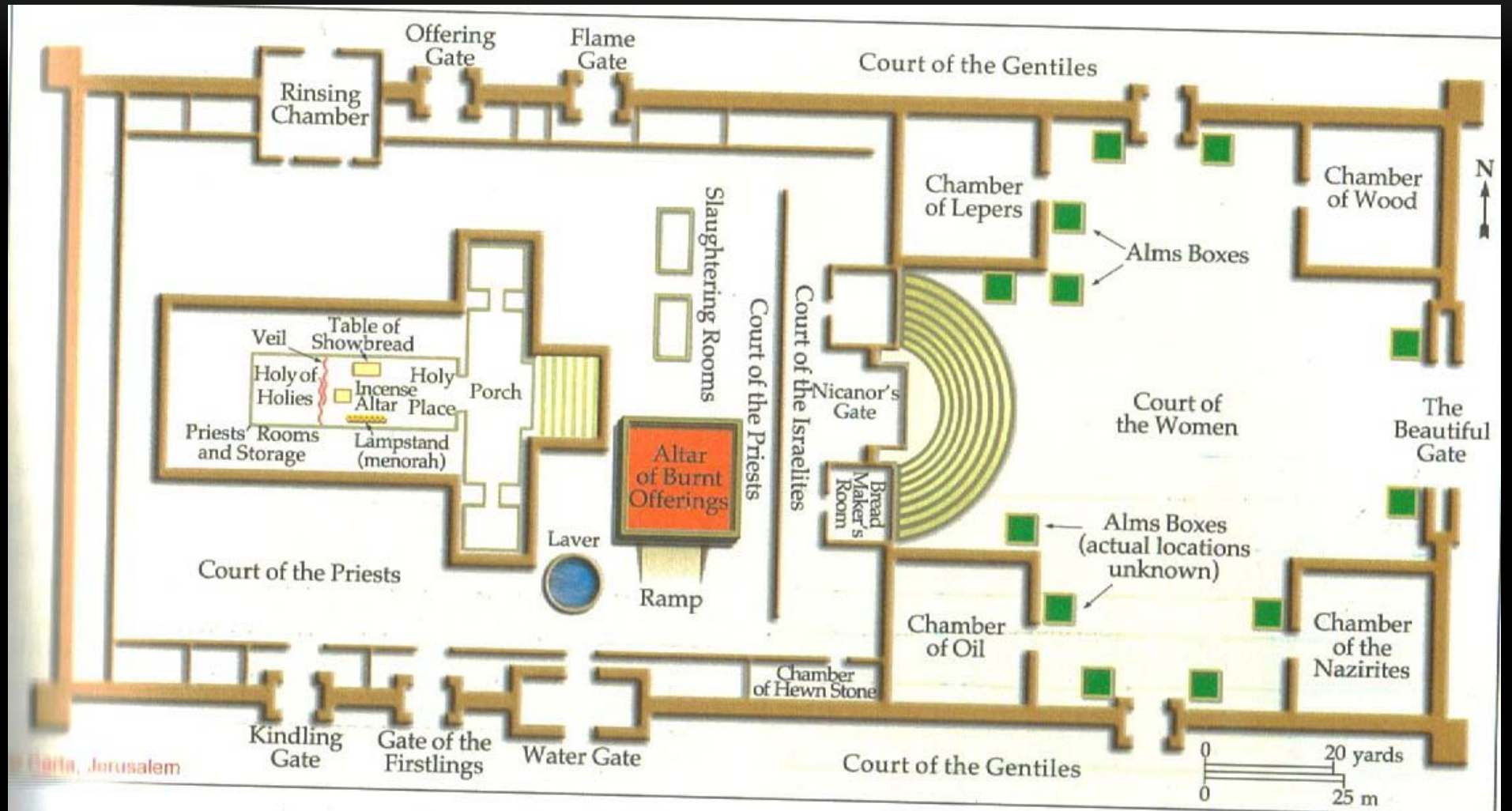


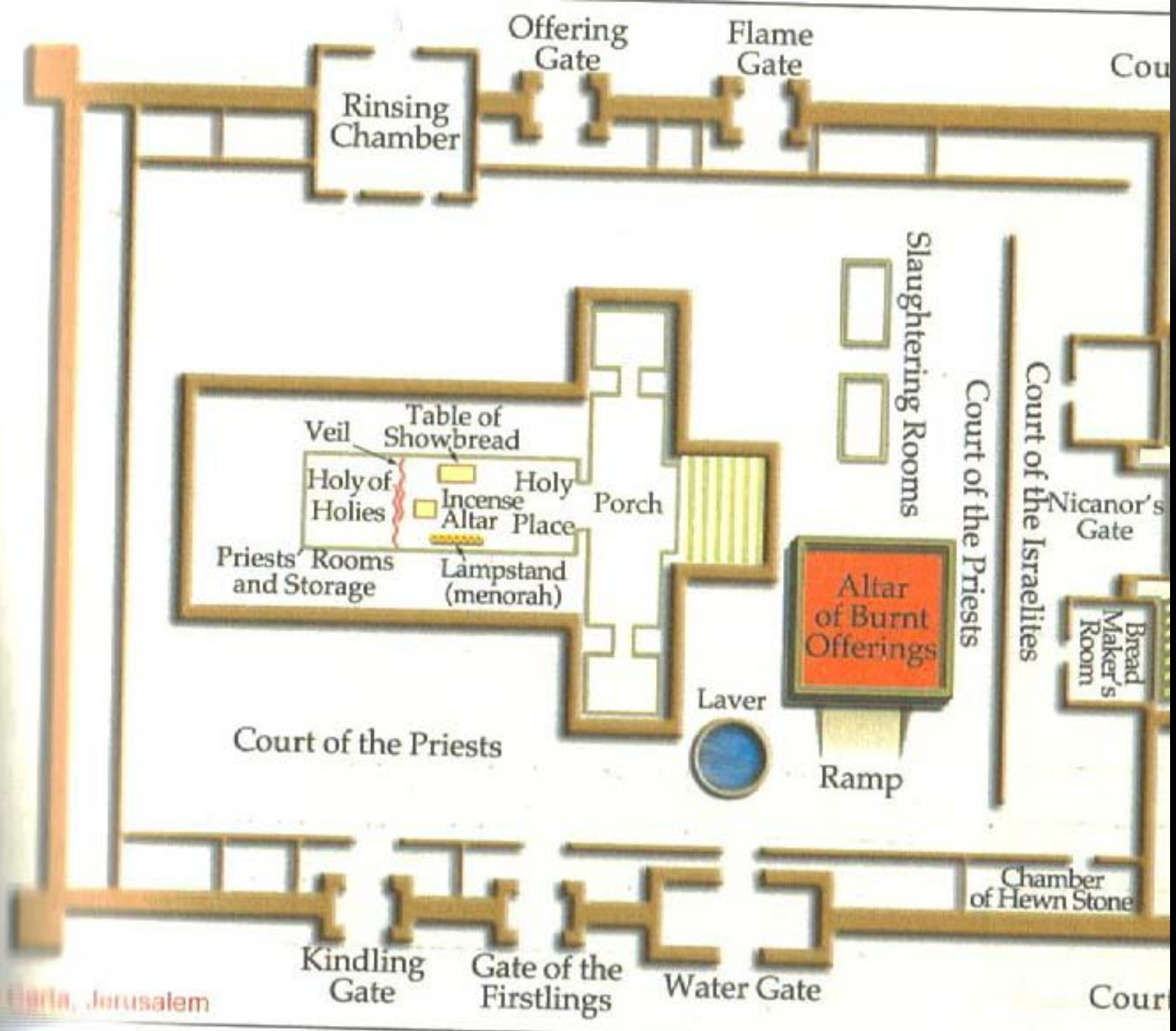
