- Isaiah 61:2

*“To proclaim the favorable year of the LORD
And the day of vengeance of our God”*

The Gospel of Luke

- Isaiah 61:5-6

Strangers (Gentiles) will stand and pasture your (The Jews) flocks, And foreigners will be your farmers and your vinedressers. But you will be called the priests of the LORD; You will be spoken of as ministers of our God. You will eat the wealth of nations, And in their riches you will boast.

The Gospel of Luke

- Targum Translation

“You shall eat the possessions of the Gentiles, and in their glory you shall be indulged. Instead of your being ashamed and confounded, 2 for 1 the benefits I promise you I will bring to you, and the Gentiles will be ashamed who were boasting in their lot.”
