  - Eccl. 3:7 (there is) a time to tear, and a time to sew; a time to keep silence, and a time to speak;
  - <u>Prov. 21:23</u> Whoever keeps his mouth and his tongue keeps himself out of trouble.
  - Prov. 18:21a Death and life are in the power of the tongue,

<u>Prov. 17:27</u> Whoever <u>restrains</u> his words has knowledge, and he who has a cool spirit is a man of understanding. [28] Even a fool who keeps silent is considered wise; when he closes his lips, he is deemed intelligent.

Knowledge without wisdom (knowing when/how to use it) & discernment (sensing the Spirit's prodding) is more than worthless, it is damaging
