Jesus says, "I am your King!"

- •Why would we need or want this King?
 - 1. Our world is broken
 - 2. There is a broken ruler in place (John 12:31; 2 Corinthians 4:4; 1 John 5:19)
 - 3. We need a benevolent ruler!

Jesus Declares His Kingship by...

1.Riding on a Donkey (Zechariah 9:9-10)

Why? What is He doing?

- I am not coming to slay you. I am coming to save you!
- Jesus is declaring his humble, gentile, saving, Jewish and global kingship.

Jesus Declares His Kingship by...

- 1.Riding on a Donkey (Zechariah 9:9-10)
- 2.Cleansing the Temple (Isaiah 56:6-8)
 - a) Jesus is putting himself in the position of the coming king.
 - b) Context is global, not just Jewish

What was this showing?

- I am the coming king!
- 2 Samuel 5:6-10 and 1 Chronicles 11:4-6Jesus did to the Temple's traditions what he did with the money-changers' tables: **he turned them upside down**.
- It is not just a kingship over other kings, but over all brokenness.
