<u>In Chapter 24</u> - Jesus prophecies the destruction of Jerusalem & the Temple The very place that was meant to be where Heaven & earth joined

<u>In Chapter 25</u> - Jesus pours out Parable after Parable about the lateness of the hour that is upon His audience & the need to decide if Jesus is the kind of God people want

Worship intellect, being seen as smart, you will end up feeling stupid, a fraud, always on the verge of being found out."
